According to that announcement, a G.O was issued to form TANFINET Co. Govt's contribution of Rs.50 Lakhs has been released for TANFINET and steps are on to register the Co and take up the preliminary works.

The MoU signed between the Central & State Govts has been exchanged in the presence of Shri Edappadi K. Palaniswami, Chief Minister of TN, at the Secretariat, on Tuesday.
